Kit List

Actors working on this film shoot must arrive dressed as a Cub Scout.

Listed below is the clothing required. Everything should be clearly marked with the owner's name and packed in two bags. Sports bags are ideal. No suitcases please.

Rollmat (optional)

Sleeping bag & a blanket (a small pillow if required.) These need to be packed in one of the bags. The stuff bag for the sleeping bag is no good on it's own as it is not waterproof. All this bedding needs to be together in one bag.

Trousers & shorts. Training or combat trousers are better than jeans as they dry quicker.

T-shirts & jumper – no football shirts please.

Hiking boots or wellies (Please check that wellies still fit!)

Trainers

Underwear

Pyjamas

Waterproof coat (not just shower proof - we don't stay in if it rains!)

Washing gear & towel. Toothbrush & paste. Baby wipes are better than soap & flannel. All in a bag (drawstring if possible).

Tea towel – an old one & you won't want it back (trust me!)

Torch with fresh batteries!

Sun Hat

Optional

Teddy etc. (my daughter is an adult now and will still be bringing hers!)

Paper & pencils, book to read, camera.

IPods, mobile phones, DS Lites etc. are **not** allowed.

NO penknives - Cubs are not allowed to carry these.

No money is required.

Useful Information

You will need a packed lunch for Saturday – we will supply drinks. If you bring this in a small rucksack this can be used later in the week for the Hike. **No lunch boxes** please, they are difficult to store.

Please send a cake wrapped in foil. Preferably fruit cake or something that will keep.

Health

Keith Davis, Merlin's Akela, will be our designated first aider for the week, although all Leaders are qualified first aiders. Please complete the attached health information form and return it with the balance. **Your son will not be able to camp without it.** It is important that you advise us of any allergies or special health or dietary requirements beforehand. EG. Bed wetting, allergy to nuts, vegetarians, plaster allergy etc.

If your son is taking any form of medication, please mark it clearly with his name and dosage instructions and pass to Keith on arrival.

Please make sure your son helps to pack his bags so that he knows what he has. It's not unusual for no-one to claim an item of clothing because the cub owner doesn't recognise it. Also please ensure that your son has everything on the list – please don't assume because the weather has been nice recently that he will not need a coat or wellies! Ensure that his scarf & cub jumper & tee-shirts are all named as they all look the same!

Please do not send supplies of food – cubs are not allowed food in their tents as it encourages wildlife! Your son will not be hungry – we have a cooked breakfast, a large lunch and a filling dinner daily. Plus elevenses, afternoon tea and supper. We also serve bread & butter with all meals. And we supply tuck every afternoon! In fact, we seem to spend most of our time eating

Please write to your son while he is on the cruise. If you post it before they go it should arrive after a couple of days. The address is:

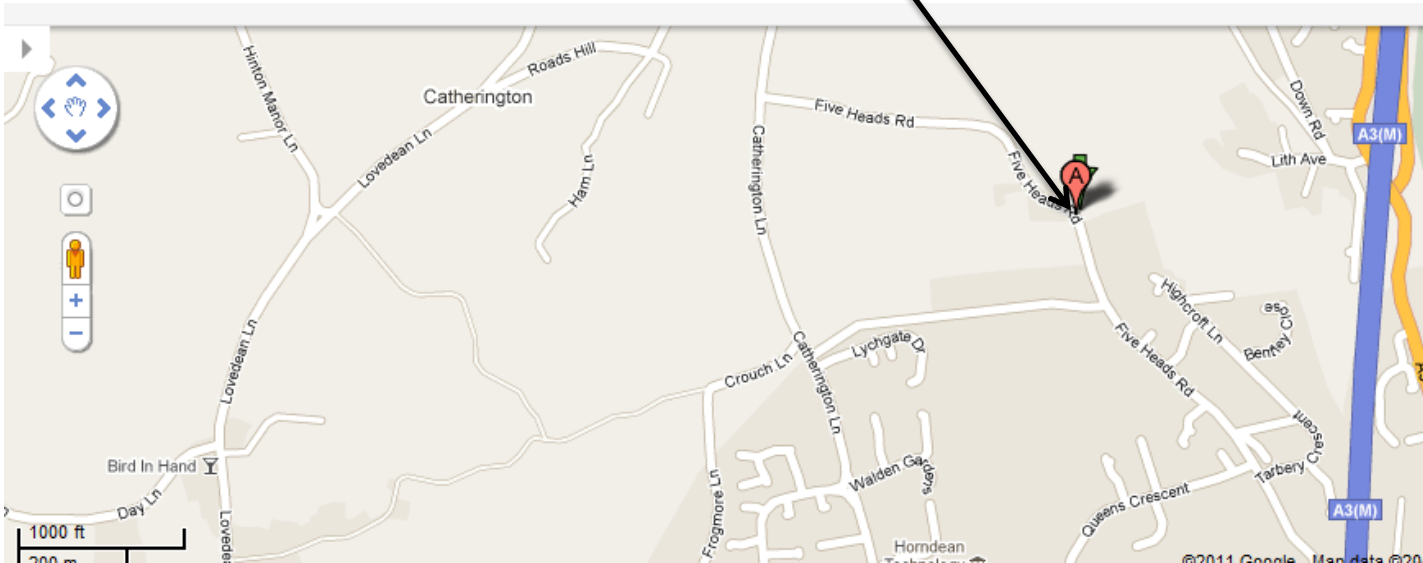
